Entries on the day are welcomed, please ensure that you are registered at Race HQ in time for the assembly of runners at 12:45. Race HQ is located in the Atholl Leisure Centre, please look for signs directing you to the Leisure Centre on the Main street.

Limited changing and showers are available at the Leisure Centre.

Water will be available at the half way point and at the finishing area. Other Refreshments can be purchased from the Leisure Centre.

If you require results please place name and address on the envelope provided together with 50p late registration. Results be posted on the event web site as soon after the event as possible.

**The Course:** There will be a "warm up" walk to the start, with the finish off road on a footpath. The route is a multi terrain course that is not suitable for spikes or studs. Please obey instructions of Marshals for your own safety, take special care at road crossings and at some areas through woodlands.
