

Award Categories and Criteria

General criteria for all awards:

- The person or team nominated must be a resident in Perth and Kinross for at least 6 months prior to the event and/or be affiliated to a club/sport in Perth and Kinross.
- The sport must be officially recognised by **sportscotland**.
- Nominations will be judged on the entry form alone with the exception of main Sports Person of the Year Award

Sports Person of the Year

Sponsored by Live Active Leisure

This year we are requesting suggestions from the Perth & Kinross public to help decide who the candidates should be for the Sports Person of the Year. The final decision for the award winner will be made by the 2016 Partners of Perth & Kinross Sports Person of the Year.

- Must be 18 years or over.
- Has achieved considerable success in their chosen sport in a competitive environment in 2016.



School Team of the Year

This will be awarded to a school team that has been successful in local, national or international schools competition during 2016.

- Must be pupils from the same school.
- More than one team per school can be nominated.
- Based on success relevant to level at which the team participates.
- Based on results of the team and not results of individuals who make up the team.

- The club is open to all sectors of the community.
- Committed to training, recruiting and recognising volunteers and coaches.
- Can evidence ongoing development of the club.
