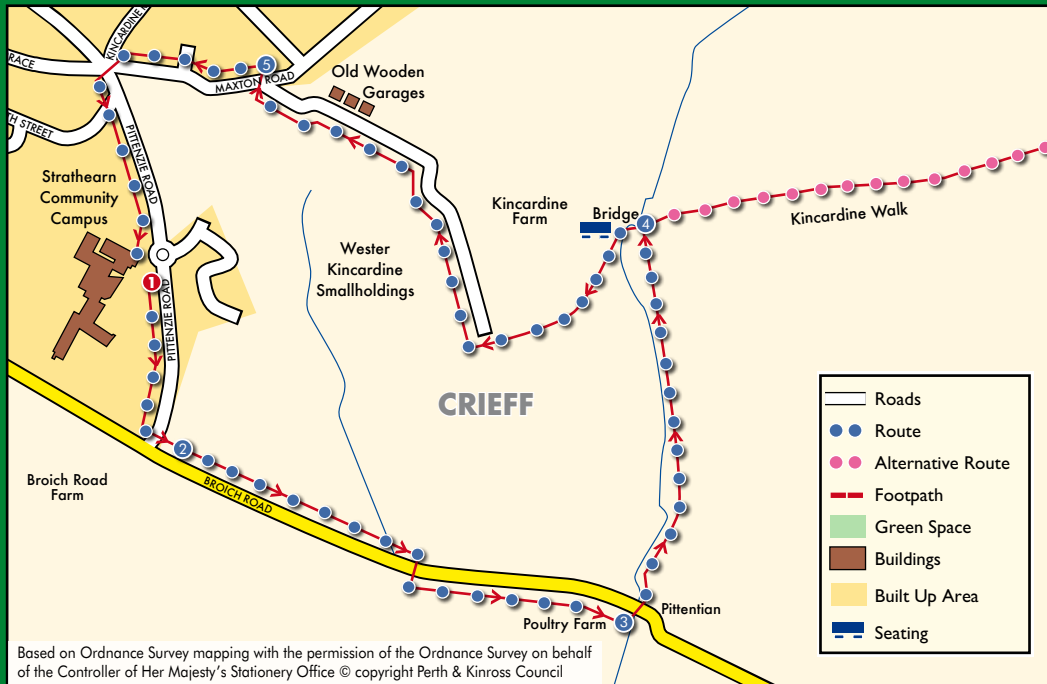


CRIEFF Kincardine Farm Walk

This walk is suitable for buggies (with assistance) & bikes.  

ROUTE DESCRIPTION:

Distance: 2.5 miles approx

Approx time: 70 - 80 minutes

Terrain: Both rough and smooth surfaces.

Start: **Strathearn Community Campus, Pittenzie Road**

- 1 Exit Strathearn Community Campus and turn right onto Pittenzie Road. Follow the road down to Broich Road; turn left.
- 2 Follow the pavement as far as it goes. When it ends, cross over and walk for approx. 400m in the direction of oncoming traffic until you cross over a stream; watch for cars. You'll notice a wall on the bend of the road with the name "Pittentian"; turn left.
- 3 Head up the dirt track until it forks. Take the left fork and continue up the short rise past houses to the farm gate; turn left.
- 4 Cross a small bridge. There's a seat so take in the view. You are now on the 'Kincardine Walk'. Follow the path all the way back into Crieff past wooden garages on your right hand side. When you reach Maxton Road turn left.
- 5 Continue straight until you reach Pittenzie Road where you'll turn left and head back to Strathearn Community Campus

●●● Kincardine Walk (Add 0.5 miles out and back)

Crieff developed into the main cattle trading centre in Scotland between 16th and 18th centuries. Drovers and up to 30,000 black cattle would converge on this huge livestock market - must have been pretty spectacular!

Getting to the start of the walk



No. 45 Bus leaves from Crieff Town Centre, down to Strathearn Community Campus at regular intervals.

There is parking at Strathearn Community Campus.



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
