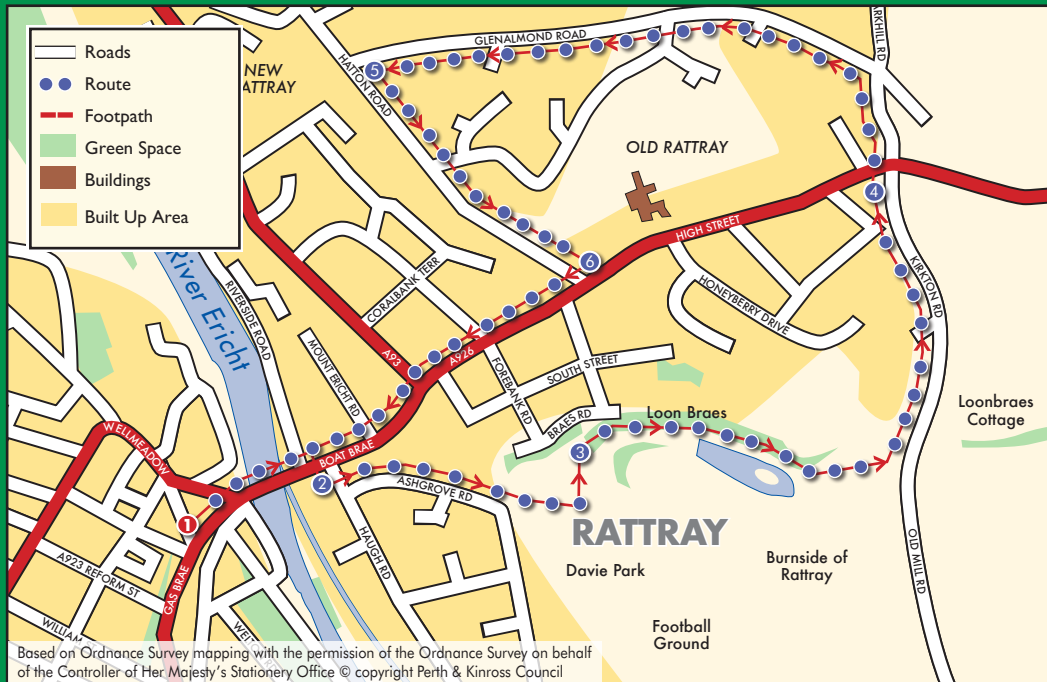


BLAIRGOWRIE Rattray Parks



This is also suitable for wheelchairs (with assistance), buggies & bikes.    (Watch crossing busy main roads)

ROUTE DESCRIPTION:

Distance: 2.2 miles approx.
Approx time: 60 - 80 minutes
Terrain: Both rough and smooth surfaces
Start: **The Wellmeadow, Blairgowrie Town Centre**

- ① Starting from the Wellmeadow, head over the bridge and River Ericht onto Boat Brae; turn right onto Haugh Road.
- ② Head onto Haugh Road about immediately left onto Ashgrove Road. Before the road turns right, head into the park and walk towards the new play area - always worth a stop with kids.
- ③ You'll continue through the park past the pond and take the track on the left which leads onto Kirkton Road; turn left and head towards the High Street.
- ④ Cross over the main road (be careful) onto Parkhill Road. When you come to Glensalmond Road turn left and head all the way along to the end of the road.
- ⑤ Turn left onto Hatton Road. This will take you down past the play park by Rattray Primary School; again worth a stop.
- ⑥ From here turn right on the High Street and retrace your steps back to the Wellmeadow.

As mentioned, the parks are worth a visit; a swing can lift anyone's spirit. Look around at the Wellmeadow as there are a few nice spots to stop and have a coffee or sit and let the world pass you by.
