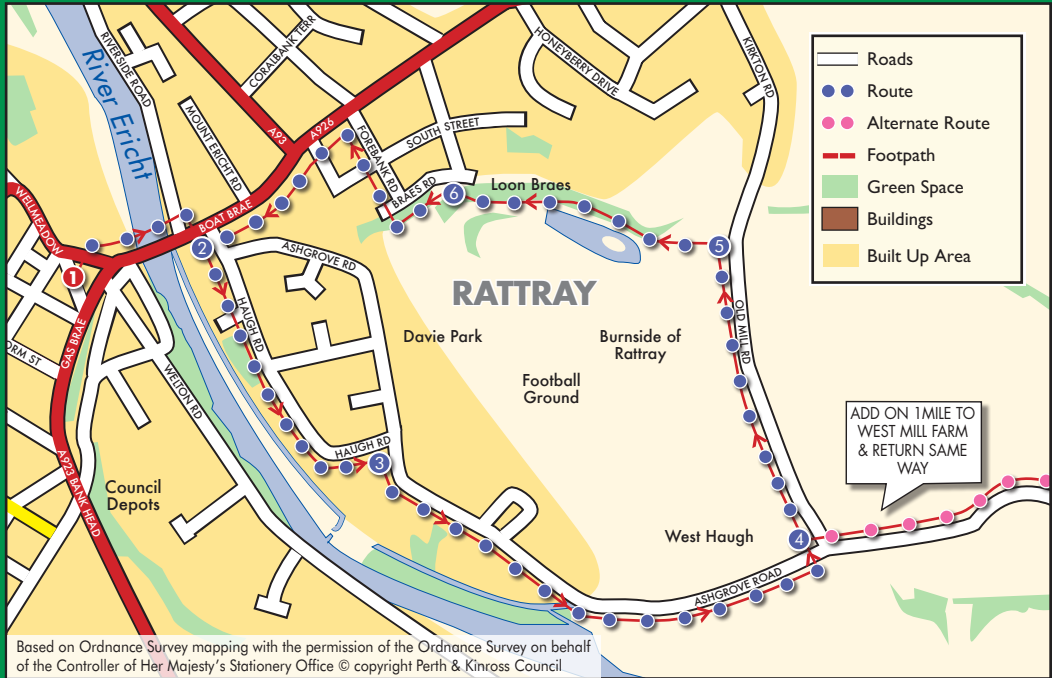


BLAIRGOWRIE West Haugh from Wellmeadow



This is also suitable for wheelchairs (with assistance), buggies & bikes.    (Watch crossing busy main roads)

ROUTE DESCRIPTION:

Distance: 2 miles approx.

Approx time: 60 minutes

Terrain: Both rough and smooth surface

Start: **The Wellmeadow, Blairgowrie Town Centre**

- 1 Starting from the Wellmeadow, head towards the bridge crossing over the River Ericht onto Boat Brae; turn right onto Haugh Road.
- 2 Head along Haugh Road and follow it round until you meet Ashgrove Road; turn right.
- 3 Continue along past open fields and the River Ericht. You'll start to notice fruit fields. In the summer the smell is lovely. When you come to Old Mill Road take a left.
- 4 Walk along here for approx 1/3 of a mile and you'll notice a brae on your left taking you into Davie Park and the duck pond; take it.
- 5 Head through the park until you come to Braes Road. It might be worth stopping to let the kids play a while.
- 6 Head along Braes Road, right onto Forebank Road and head back to the bridge via Boat Brae. Retrace your steps back to Wellmeadow.

Blairgowrie and Perthshire are well known as a rich soft fruit growing area; raspberries, strawberries etc. There are several farms where you can drop by and pick your own fruit.
