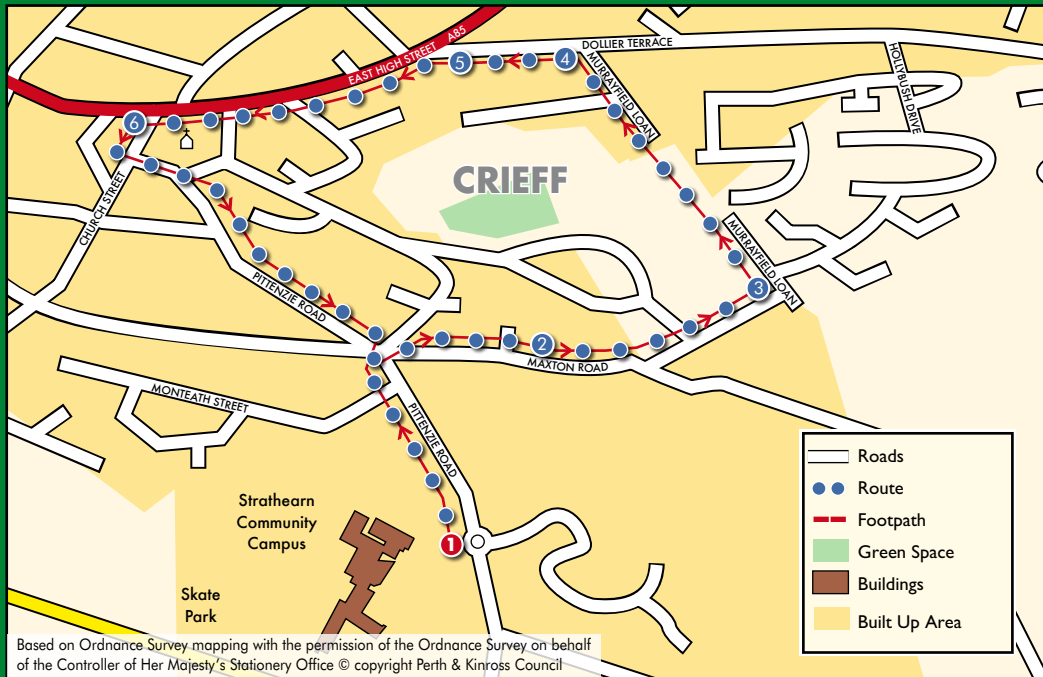


# CRIEFF The Town Circuit Walk



This walk is suitable for wheelchairs (with assistance), buggies & bikes.   

## ROUTE DESCRIPTION:

**Distance:** 2.0 miles approx.

**Approx time:** 60 - 70 minutes

**Terrain:** Smooth surfaces

**Start:** **Strathearn Community Campus, Pittenzie Road**

- 1 Exit Strathearn Community Campus and turn left onto Pittenzie Road. Follow the road to the crossroads and turn right onto Kincardine Road which leads onto Maxton Road.
- 2 Follow Maxton Road round and up hill until you reach Murrayfield Loan; turn left.
- 3 Continue straight along Murrayfield Loan. You'll notice a path at the end of the road through a green space. Take it as it leads onto the continuation of Murrayfield Loan.
- 4 When you reach Dollerie Terrace turn left and left again when you come to the High Street.
- 5 Walk down the High Street and turn left at Church Street.
- 6 Walk down Church Street turning left again onto Bank Street and then first right onto Pittenzie Road. Follow this road all the way to the crossroads and retrace your steps back to Strathearn Community Campus.

**NB: This walk has gradients and will require a certain level of fitness, especially if pushing a buggy or helping a wheelchair user. Bikers must be careful on roads.**
