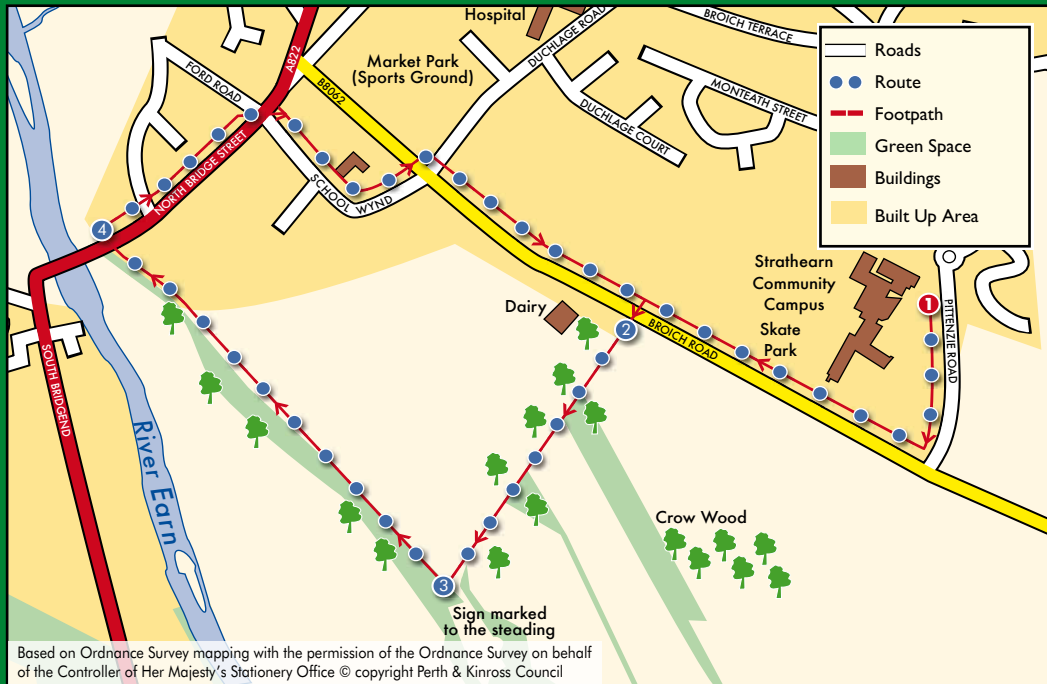


CRIEFF Riverside Walk



This walk is suitable for wheelchairs (with assistance), buggies & bikes.   

ROUTE DESCRIPTION:

Distance: 2 miles approx.

Approx time: 60 - 70 minutes

Terrain: Both rough and smooth surface

Start: **Strathearn Community Campus, Pittenzie Road**

- 1 Exit Strathearn Community Campus and turn right onto Pittenzie Road heading down to Broich Road. Turn right and stick to the pavement. As you approach the Dairy you'll notice a driveway/track through trees on the left that leads down to the riverside. Cross the road and take it.
- 2 Follow the driveway until it forks. You'll notice a gate and track on the right hand side.
- 3 Pass through the gate and walk along the riverside until you come to North Bridge Street; turn right.
- 4 Carry on straight turning right onto School Wynd and right again onto Broich Road. When you pass the Dairy retrace your steps back to the Strathearn Community Campus.
